I. Pray _____ The Reality Of The Conflict

A. Pray acknowledging the spiritual conflict

Eph. 6:10-12 “A final word: Be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on all of God’s armor so that you will be able to stand firm against all strategies of the devil. For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places.” (NLT)

B. Pray in order to stay _____

I Peter 5:8-9 “Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith... ” (NLT)

II. Pray _____ Your Role In The Conflict

A. Refuse to be an observer of the spiritual battle

Eph. 6:13 “Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything to stand.” (NIV)

II Cor. 6:7 “in truthful speech and in the power of God; with weapons of righteousness in the right hand and in the left.” (NIV)

B. Commit to a _____ of battling with prayer

*Eph. 6:18 “Pray in the Spirit **at all times and on every occasion**. Stay alert and **be persistent** in your prayers for **all believers everywhere**.” (NLT)*

Col. 4:2 “Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart.” (NLT)

III. Pray _____ In Response To The Conflict

A. Pray against demonic activity

II Cor. 10:3-4 “For though we walk (live) in the flesh, we are not carrying on our warfare according to the flesh and using mere human weapons. For the weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood], but they are mighty before

God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds.” (Amplified)

*Eph. 6:18 “Pray in the Spirit at all times and on every occasion. Stay alert and be persistent in your prayers **for all believers everywhere.**” (NLT)*

Luke 18:1 “One day Jesus told his disciples a story to show that they should always pray and never give up.” (NLT)
